The teams

Favorite: Bergen Catholic
Contenders: St. Mary's, Don Bosco, Paramus, River Dell.
Lowdown: Bergen Catholic should add to its seven straight tournament titles and 13 overall. The Crusaders have the deepest lineup, led by returning State champion Joe Trause and seniors Matt Morgenstern and George Kocher. The battle should come for second place between St. Mary's, which finished third last year, and Don Bosco, which finished fifth.

Contenders: Mike DeMarco, St. Mary's; Dan Davenport, Hasbrouck Heights/Wood-Ridge; Dave Della Torre, River Dell; Michael Raccioppi, Hackensack.
Lowdown: Cagnina showed himself to be the class of this weight, winning five of six bouts to finish third at the Beast of the East. DeMarco is a returning district and region champ and could give Cagnina a run in the final.

eventual State champion Fred Santaite of Northern Highlands in last year's Holiday Tournament final. Adamo, a district second and region fourth at 103 last year, can also find his way to the final, but either one can easily be upset along the road.

Favorite: Fred Santaite, Northern Highlands (103 champ last year)
Contenders: Bob Dabal, North Bergen; Mike Quinn, Pascack Valley.

Lowdown: The likely showdown between Santaite, a returning State champ, and Dabal, a returning State fifth, should be one of the most exciting finals of the night. Dabal, last year's 112-pound champion, beat Santaite two years ago in the semifinals on the way to winning his first tournament title. It was the only meeting between the two.

Favorite: Joe Trause, Bergen Catholic (112 champ last year)
Contenders: John Trumbetti, St. Joseph; Joe Kover, Fair Lawn; Matt Fusco, St. Mary's.

Lowdown: The dream matchup is a State championship rematch between Trause and Trumbetti in the final. Trause shocked Trumbetti in the final moments in Atlantic City for a one-point victory in the 119-pound State final. Trumbetti, last year's 119-pound Holiday Tournament champ, could become just the fifth four-time champion in the 47-year history of the tournament, but St. Joseph coach Gary Riotta is not sure if he will wrestle in this weight class and there are rumors he is nursing an injured rib. Trause is coming off an injured hand that cost him a trip to the Beast of the East.

Favorite: Taylor Trumbetti, Pascack Hills
Contenders: Mike Zottarelli, Lodi; Scott Albrecht, Mahwah; Tony Dussault, Hasbrouck Heights/Wood-Ridge; P.J. Flores, Fair Lawn.

Lowdown: This class could come down to Trumbetti, a 35-bout winner and State qualifier as a freshman last season, and Zottarelli, who finished third in the Holiday Tournament at 119 last season. Albrecht is a returning district second and region fourth. Dussault is coming off a title in the Garfield Tournament.

Favorite: Dale Fava, Don Bosco
Contenders: Matt Spataro, Bergen Catholic; Tom Murphy, Northern Highlands; Joe Yuskaitis, Fair Lawn.
Lowdown: Fava, a returning State third, has set his sights on a

State championship. Spataro lost in the first round here as a freshman last year but improved steadily through the season and went on to a district championship and region fourth. Yuskaitis was also a district champ and Murphy a district third.

Favorite: Derek Steuben, Northern Highlands
Contenders: Tony Cariddi, River Dell; Emmanuel Ajagbe, Bergen Catholic.
Lowdown: Steuben and Cariddi both surprised last season. Steuben, wrestling in a packed 135-pound class, stunned Fava to win the Region 2 title. Cariddi was the toast of last season's Holiday Tournament, battling up from the 11th seed to win the 130-pound class and earn the tournament's Most Outstanding Wrestler.

Favorite: Matt Morgenstern, Bergen Catholic (defending champ)
Contenders: John Dack, Don Bosco; Nick Natoli, Hasbrouck Heights/Wood-Ridge
Lowdown: Morgenstern's run to a second straight title will be made easier by Frank Buena-fuente's jump to 152 this year. Dack, a returning region runner-up, and Natoli can give him a challenge but more than likely will be battling for second place.

Favorite: Frank Buena-fuente, Garfield
Contenders: Dan Adamo, De-

marost; Joe Sargenti, Don Bosco; Matt MacLean, Old Tappan; Jeremy Pierce, Hackensack.
Lowdown: Buena-fuente placed seventh in the state. This year he's looking for bigger things, and it would start with his first Holiday Tournament title. Adamo finished second in the Holiday Tournament and second in the region to River Dell's Darryl Cocozzo last year.

Favorite: Dan Zotollo, Paramus
Contenders: Mark Peck, Hasbrouck Heights/Wood-Ridge; Tyler Hesse, Emerson/Park Ridge; Juan Vega, St. Mary's; Mike Magaraci, Old Tappan; Nick Vetterlein, St. Mary's.
Lowdown: This is another deep weight class. Zotollo, a returning region runner-up, beat North Bergen's Ricco Rodriguez on the way to the Holiday Tournament final last year. Rodriguez beat Peck in their region final later in the season.

Favorite: Dan Rinaldi, Lodi (160 champ last season)
Contenders: Jonathan Becker, Bergen Catholic; Mike Sweeney, Hasbrouck Heights/Wood-Ridge; Kevin Ramishvili, Fair Lawn.
Lowdown: Rinaldi beat Becker, 2-1, in two overtimes in their only meeting last season to win the Region 2 championship and went on to finish seventh in the state with 34 wins. Becker will be looking for some revenge.

Contenders: Philip Hawes, Ridgefield Park/Ridgefield; Kyle Hemmer, Dumont; Devin Hudson, River Dell; Dan Talone, Mahwah; Vinnie Cevetello, St. Mary's; Kuntle Bamisile, Hackensack.
Lowdown: This has got to be the deepest class in the tournament. Lisanti and Hawes are returning region runners-up and Hemmer, who finished third in the Holiday Tournament, was a region fourth last season.

Favorite: George Kocher, Bergen Catholic
Contenders: Luke Stala, Don Bosco; Adam Koziol, Paramus; Joe Regina, St. Mary's.
Lowdown: Kocher had the misfortune last season of being in the same weight class as Lodi's Keith Dobish, who beat him in the Holiday and Region 2 finals. This season it's his turn to sit atop the bracket after winning 32 bouts qualifying for the State tournament last season.

Favorite: Chris Farulla, Leonia/Palisades Park
Contenders: Mike Farr, Don Bosco; Kevin Hill, New Milford; Zach Taylor, Northern Highlands.
Lowdown: With returning champion Randy Martinez of Teaneck sitting out the season after shoulder surgery from football, this weight class has opened up for Farulla and Farr. Farulla beat Farr, 5-2, in the Region 2 consolation round to reach the State tournament.

Bosco's Fava has more work to do

Sets his sights on winning State championship

Dale Fava has won three district titles and two region titles.

Last season, he finished third in the state and he recently finished fourth in the national Beast of the East Tournament in Delaware.

But none of that has quieted his father, Dale Sr.

"He keeps telling me, 'You never won the County. You never won the County,'" the senior from Don Bosco said with a smile. "Christmas and Christmas Eve, my mother is ripping me to go out and run."

They shouldn't have bothered, because Fava doesn't need any more motivation. The day after helping the Ironmen win the State Non-Public Group 4 football championship as a 142-pound cornerback, he was on the mats at Bosco getting ready for wrestling season.

"I kind of celebrated that night, and the next day I was wrestling," Fava said following a 2½-hour practice the day after Christmas. "My expectations are to go out and win all my matches and win the State title at 135 pounds."

"It's pretty cut and dried," Bosco coach Nunzio Campanile said.

"His goal is to be the State champion."

That road continues this weekend at the 47th annual BCCA George Jockish Holiday Wrestling Tournament. This year, the tournament moves north to Rockland Community College in Suffern (N.Y.) while Paramus High School undergoes construction that has depleted available parking for the event.

"It's a big-time motivation for me," Fava said. "My first goal is to win the County tournament. It's something I haven't done."

Fava lost twice in the tourna-

ment to David Greenwald of St. Mary's, including a 7-5 loss in the final (just two days after having a cast removed from the hand he broke playing football), and once to Rutherford's Cory Dunn. Both opponents have finished second in the State.

Fava, who burst onto the scene in Bergen County by winning the Region 2 title as a freshman in 2004, has succeeded in a weight class that typically is dominated by year-round wrestlers rather than football players like himself. Dunn was one of the exceptions, playing running back for Rutherford.

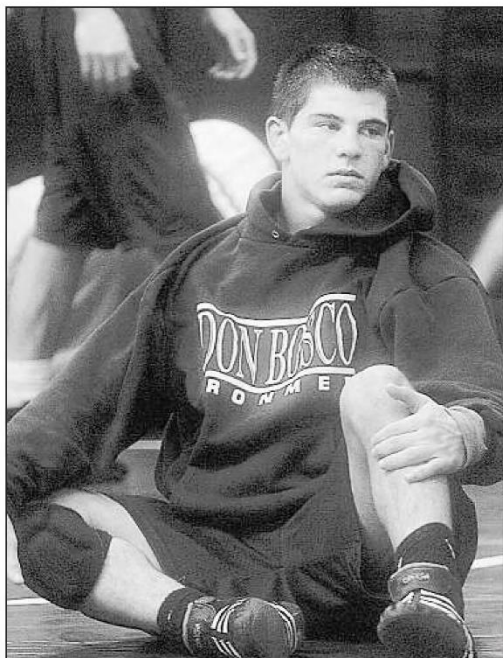
"It may put him at a disadvantage conditioning-wise at the beginning of the season," said Campanile, the offensive coordinator on the Bosco football staff. "But he's been able to continue playing."

"It's a big transition," Fava said about going from football to wrestling. "I've been doing it since freshman year. But I don't find myself at a disadvantage. In football, I'm going up against 189-pounders every day. Every single kid is bigger than I am. But when I get on the mat, everybody's the same size."

Fava put his time to good use during the summer, wrestling in several national dual tournaments as part of Team New Jersey. Earlier this month, he finished fourth in the Beast, going the distance with top-seeded Max Shanaman of Blair before falling, 1-0, in the semifinal. "I was OK with it," he said. "But it was my first big match, and I was too hesitant. That taught me to open up and wrestle my style."

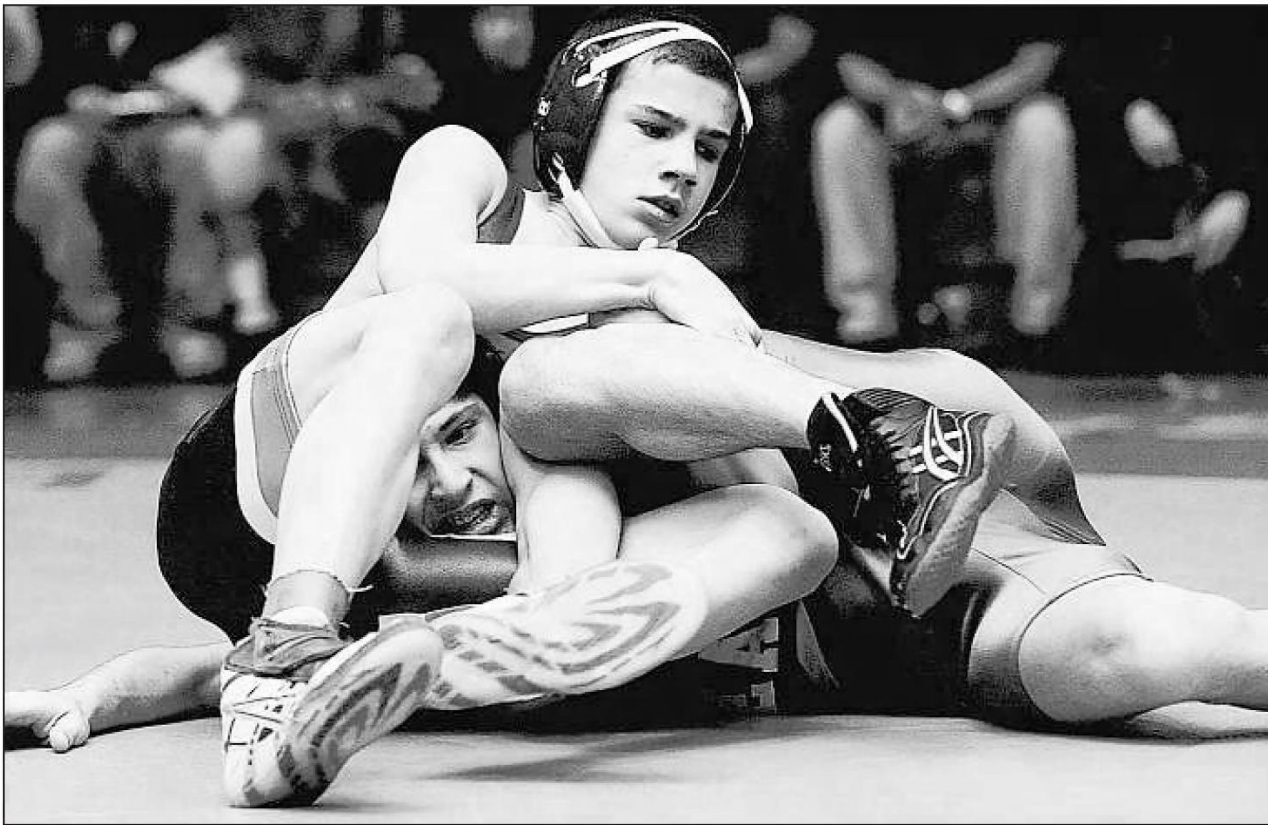
It's a style he hopes will take him to the State final in Atlantic City.

"Each year I've been trying to go another round, another round," he said. "This is my turn to go to the finals. I've got one State championship [football]. Now I have to get out and get the other."

Feel-good wins

Ortiz, Butcher enjoy mild upsets

SUFFERN, N.Y. — Joe Ortiz got a measure of revenge. Dan Butcher got a shot of redemption.

Ortiz, a sophomore from Paramus, and Butcher, a junior from Westwood, each posted a mild upset Friday night in the quarterfinals of the BCCA George Jockish Holiday Wrestling Tournament at Rockland Community College.

"It feels good," said Butcher, the fifth seed at 130. "I got past this round in my freshman year, but got knocked out of it pretty early as a sophomore."

Butcher, who finished third in the tournament his freshman year, downed fourth-seeded Tony Dussault of Hasbrouck Heights/Wood-Ridge, 7-3, in their quarterfinal, his third bout of the day. That win set up a semifinal match this morning against top-seeded Taylor Trumbetti of Pascack Hills, who rolled into the semifinals with a pin and a 5-0 victory over Rutherford's Rob Fecanin in his quarterfinal.

It will be the first time Butcher wrestles Trumbetti, but the two are more than familiar with each other.

"We're really good friends," Butcher said. "We work out against each other all the time. When we were younger, we wrestled on the same team."

And since then, they've wrestled each other whenever they get the chance.

"It's kind of hard because he knows what you're going to do," Butcher said. "But I feel pretty good to be here, because I wasn't picked to do anything in this tournament."

Ortiz, also seeded fifth, wasn't picked to go far in the tournament either, but Friday night, he avenged a loss in the Region 2 fifth-place consolation bout last season by beating tough Nick Adamo of Demarest, the fourth seed, 7-6.

"It's really big because I knew I had to win that match to make the top four," said Ortiz, who had pins of 13 seconds and 1:34 in his first two bouts. "With this win, I'll be right there."

Ortiz will face top-seeded Jose Vega of Hasbrouck Heights/Wood-Ridge in today's semifinals. Vega posted technical falls in each of his first two bouts to march into the semifinals.

"I worked hard all summer, and I wanted to show everybody how the hard work has paid off," Ortiz said. "I just want to

wrestle my best. If I win, I'm in the final. If I lose, it's to the top seed."

The few upsets on the first day of the tournament all came when fifth seeds beat fourth seeds. For the most part, the seeds held true as the tournament made a once-only detour to the cavernous Rockland CC Fieldhouse because of construction at Paramus High School.

Don Bosco held a slim lead over St. Mary and Bergen Catholic in the team scores through the quarterfinals. Bosco led with 150 points with one wrestleback round still to be contested Friday night followed by the Gaels with 142½ and Bergen Catholic with 142. All three teams were tied for the lead in the tournament with seven wrestlers advancing to the semifinals.

Returning champions Fred Santaite of Northern Highlands and Bobby Dabal of North Bergen are charging headlong to a marquee showdown and possible State final preview in the 119-pound final. Top-seeded Santaite, a returning State champion, and second-seeded Dabal, a returning State fifth, have never faced each other.

Wrestling begins at 11 o'clock this morning with the finals likely to begin around 5:30.

Top-seeded Mike DeMarco and fifth-seeded Frank Cagnina advanced to the semifinals along with unseeded Jason Dack of Don Bosco and Alex Preefer of Cresskill. DeMarco and Cagnina each pinned in their two bouts of the day with Cagnina stopping fifth-seeded Dan Davenport of Hasbrouck Heights/Wood-Ridge in 2:42 in the quarterfinals.

Top-seeded Jose Vega of Hasbrouck Heights/Wood-Ridge posted technical falls in his first two bouts to advance to the semifinals against fifth-seeded Joe Ortiz of Paramus. Vinny Fava of Don Bosco downed second-seeded Anthony Raccioppi, 11-3, in his opening bout and scored a first-period pin in the quarterfinals.

119

Returning State champion Fred Santaite of Northern Highlands and returning State fifth Bobby Dabal of North Bergen are on a collision course for one of the most entertaining finals in tournament history. Victories by top-seeded Santaite over St. Mary's Peter Ruiz and second-seeded Dabal over third-seeded Mike Quinn of Pascack Valley in today's semifinals would set up a possible preview of the State final.

Matt Fusco of St. Mary will get a chance to avenge one

of his two losses last season when he faces top-seeded and returning State champ Joe Trause of Bergen Catholic in today's semifinal. Fusco pinned in two of his three bouts while Trause posted a pin and two technical falls in his three bouts. Second-seeded Joe Kover of Fair Lawn and third-seeded Anthony Bachmann of Rutherford are in the other semifinal.

130

Glenn Cannici of St. Mary posted a 1-0 victory over second-seeded Louis Pietranuono of Bergen Catholic to advance to the semifinals against Mahwah's Scott Albrecht. Top-seeded Taylor Trumbetti of Pascack Hills cruised into the semifinals with two pins and a 5-0 decision.

135

The top four seeds easily rolled into the semifinals led by returning State third Dale Fave of Don Bosco, who will face fourth-seeded Nick Allegretta of Hackensack. Second-seeded Matt Spataro of Bergen Catholic will face third-seeded Joe Yuscaitis of Fair Lawn in the other semi.

Second-seeded Tony Cariddi of River Dell, last year's Most Outstanding Wrestler, posted three consecutive pins but earns a tough assignment in Bergen Catholic sophomore Emmanuel Ajagbe in the semifinals. Top-seeded Derek Stueben of Northern High-

lands had two pins and a technical fall to reach the semifinals against Lodi's Mark Scimeca.

All four of the top seeds had little trouble reaching the semifinals, led by top-seeded Matt Morgenstern of Bergen Catholic, who will face Ramsey's Dan Clarke in one semifinal. Second-seeded John Dack of Don Bosco and third-seeded Tommy Mullins of Hackensack will face off in the other.

Top-seeded Frank Buena-fuente of Garfield leads a talented group into the semifinals as four of the top five seeds advanced. Buena-fuente had a pin before defeating Ramsey's Steve Andolena, 16-12, in the quarterfinal and will face fifth-seeded Jeremy Pierce of Hackensack in the semifinals. Second-seeded Dan Adamo of Demarest and third-seeded Matt MacLean of Old Tappan will battle in the other semifinal.

This could be the most exciting weight class of the day. Three of the remaining four wrestlers hail from the BCSL American, led by top-seeded Anthony LiSanti of Westwood, who will face fifth-seeded Kyle Hemmer of Dumont in one semifinal. Second-seeded Phillip Hawes of Ridgefield Park/Ridgefield will face third-seeded Vinny Cevetello of St. Mary in the other.

Don Bosco's Luke Stala pushed his way in among the top four seeds with a 3-2 victory over second-seeded Adam Koziol of Paramus. He will face second-seeded Joe Regina of St. Mary, while top-seeded BC's George Kocher will face fourth-seeded Nick Pallotta of River Dell.

Top-seeded Chris Farulla of Leonia/Palisades Park led three of the top four seeds into the semifinals with two decisions. He will face fourth-seeded Tyler Blake of HH/W-R, who pinned twice. Second-seeded Mike Farr of Don Bosco will face Zach Taylor of Northern Highlands.

BC sophomore upsets Don Bosco's Fava

SUFFERN, N.Y. — Matt Spataro can stop reading about other wrestlers in the newspapers. After Saturday, the Bergen Catholic sophomore will start reading about himself.

Spataro shocked returning State third-place finisher Dale Fava of Don Bosco with a headlock, pinning him in 5:21 to win the 135-pound championship and earn the Most Outstanding Wrestler award at the 47th annual BCCA George Jockish Holiday Wrestling Tournament at Rockland Community College.

"I didn't think I'd do as well as I did," Spataro said. "I was reading all this stuff about Fava."

Spataro's win was one of the biggest reasons Bergen Catholic won a heart-stopping three-way race for its eighth straight championship and 14th overall, both tournament records. Bergen

Catholic, St. Mary and Don Bosco were separated by just five points going into the finals before the Crusaders pulled away with 217 points.

St. Mary (202½) finished second, followed by Bosco (193). The Gaels won two of the four finals they participated in while Don Bosco went 0-for-4 in the finals.

"That was tougher than the first one," BC coach Dave Bell said after the Crusaders won four championships in six finals, including three head-to-head bouts against the Gaels and Ironmen. "You don't want to let down. But it made for a better tournament. I have to give credit to St. Mary, they were awesome, and Bosco is a great competitor."

Spataro has been a great competitor at the start of his second varsity season. His win over Fava came just a week after he beat returning State runner-up Billy Ashnault of South Plainfield in a tri-meet.

Spataro took a 3-2 lead at the start of

the third period when Fava let him up. Then, with about a minute left in the third period, he caught Fava in a headlock and rolled him into the pin to wake up the crowd in the huge Rockland CC field house.

"That headlock is getting kind of notorious," Spataro said sheepishly. "This is awesome. It's a big boost for the rest of the season."

"He's probably the most dangerous wrestler on the team," Bell said. "He's tough on his feet. He's tough on the mat. He just beat Ashnault, who's a State runner-up. I told him, 'You're not wrestling to keep it close anymore. You're wrestling to win.'"

Also winning for the Crusaders were freshman Frank Cagnina (103), returning State champion Joe Trause (125) and returning Holiday champ Matt Morgenstern (145).

Returning State champion Fred Santaita of Northern Highlands won the feature bout of the night, scoring a last-

second reversal to clinch a 6-2 victory over returning State fifth Bob Dabal of North Bergen at 119.

"I was up at that point so I knew I didn't have to score to win," said Santaita, who was wrestling from the bottom for nearly the entire third period. "I just waited for him to make a mistake, and when he did I scored. That was it."

Dan Adamo stunned returning Region champ and State seventh Frank Buenafuente of Garfield, 3-1, in overtime, barely keeping his feet in bounds on the winning takedown, to win Demarest's first tournament championship since 1998.

"I didn't know I had it until I was on my way back to the mat," said Adamo, who found himself looking up at River Dell ace Darryl Cocozzo in every major tournament last year. "It's really exciting because it's the first at the school in a long time."

Rinaldi proves his championship worth

Vega dominates on his way to 160-pound title

SUFFERN, N.Y. — St. Mary's senior Juan Vega stood at the center of the championship mat on Saturday, facing an opponent who had beaten him just 10 days earlier. Lodi junior Danny Rinaldi walked onto that same mat and also faced a familiar foe. His task was to beat an opponent he needed double overtime to defeat the previous time they met.

Both tasks were difficult, but Vega and Rinaldi accomplished them, albeit in much different fashions. Vega thoroughly dominated Paramus' Dan Zotollo, posting a 13-4 majority decision in the 160-pound final of the BCCA Holiday Wrestling Tournament.

Rinaldi used an overtime takedown to defeat Bergen Catholic sophomore Jonathan Becker, 3-1, in the 171-pound final in a rematch of last year's Region 2 final, which Rinaldi won in double overtime.

Vega's title easily was the most dominant as he used a perfectly executed high crotch takedown to put Zotollo to his back and nearly pin him in the bout's opening seconds. The pin call never came despite Zotollo's back looking flat on three occasions. But that didn't deter Vega, who shook off a reversal to continue dominating the match. He used an assortment of leg attacks to frustrate Zotollo and build a large lead.

"The last time I wrestled him I had just cut nine pounds and wasn't feeling that strong," Vega said. "I knew I had to come out and outwork him. The goal for me is finishing top three in the state and if I keep wrestling like I did here I think I can get there."

"Even though we thought he got the pin early on I'm glad it didn't come because it gave Juan a chance to have a dominant match," St. Mary's coach Scot Weaver said. "There might have been people thinking he hit him with a lucky move or something,

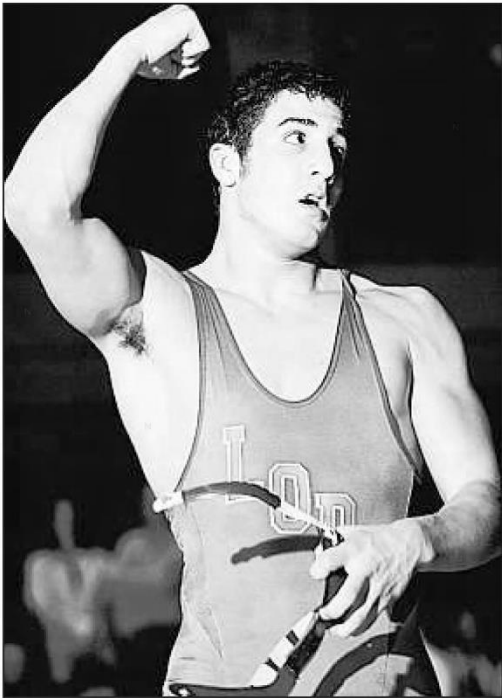
but he just took it to him for six minutes and left no doubt that he was the better wrestler."

Rinaldi won his second BCCA title in a pattern that has become the norm for many of his matches, an impenetrable defense and late takedown to pull out a close decision.

"Becker's a top-notch wrestler and you can't afford to make a mistake against a kid like him," Rinaldi said. "You figure that it's going to come down to one takedown."

"I had to adjust to his style because he just kept coming at me," Rinaldi said. "Sometimes you want to lay back and let someone else make the mistake instead of pushing things."

"He's not going to win a State title wrestling like that," Lodi coach Nick DiDomenico said of Rinaldi. "We're not content with his style tonight. We understand that Becker is an athlete and a warrior, but Danny's going to have to use more of what he has. We know what he has and he has to learn to use it."

Spataro Pin Ignites Crusaders to Eighth Straight County Crown

Bergen Catholic set a new record for a third straight year when the Crusaders captured their eighth consecutive BCCA George Jockish Holiday Tournament on Saturday at Rockland Community College in Suffern, NY. Sparked by sophomore Matt Spataro who upset Don Bosco Prep's Dale Fava to win the 135-pound title, the Crusaders accumulated 217 points in the 47th renewal while runnerup St. Mary/Rutherford finished with 202 1/2 points and the Ironmen placed third with 193 points. Spataro packed up Fava, last year's bronze medal winner in the NJSIAA State Tournament, in a headlock and pinned him

with 39 seconds remaining in the championship bout.

Freshman Frank Cagnina made his tournament debut by winning the 103-pound title, defending state champion Joe Trause repeated in the 125-pound weight division and Matt Morgestern defended his county title in the 145-pound bracket as the Crusaders won their 14th overall team championship.

In the 119-pound finale, defending state champion Fred Santaite of Northern Highlands pulled out a 6-2 decision over North Bergen's Bob Dabal who finished fifth at Atlantic City last March. Lodi's Dan Rinaldi repeated as a county champion in the

171-pound weight class.

Leonia's Chris Farulla decked Zach Taylor with 22 seconds remaining in the second period of the final bout, to capture the gold medal in the 275-pound weight division and earn Leonia's first tourney title since 1962.

Northern Valley/Demarest's Adams brothers posted two of the seven fastest falls. In the fifth place consolations, Nick Adamo posted a 50 second pin in the 112-pound confrontation while his brother Dan registered the quickest pin in 152-pound weight division of the pre-quarterfinals, posting a 20 second fall in the Olympic Wrestling Club competition. ■
